ONE VISIBLE CHURCH

- 1) "If he refuses to listen to them, tell it to the church; and if he refuses to **listen even to THE church**, let him be to you as a Gentile and a tax collector." (Matthew 18:17, NASB95)
- 2) "but in case I am delayed, I write so that you will know how one ought to conduct himself in the household of God, which is **the church of the living God, the pillar and support of the truth.**" (1 Timothy 3:15, NASB95)

TYOLOGY
